

AI Bootcamp — Two Day Workshop for Leaders and Executives

An AI bootcamp for leaders is an immersive and practical program designed to equip executives and senior professionals with a comprehensive understanding of artificial intelligence and its strategic use in business. The bootcamp begins by demystifying AI concepts, including predictive machine learning and generative AI technologies, helping leaders grasp what AI is, how it works, and its potential impact.
